2013 SUSTAINABILITY

- Increased revenue by 25% over 2012 to \$161,820 in 2013.
- Total revenue was made up of \$136,700 in private donations and foundation grants; \$24,994 in training, consulting, and membership fees, as well as new rental income from subleasing shared office space.
- **54%** of revenue was invested in direct programming, **45%** in administrative work, and **2%** in fundraising efforts.

As Spokes members, 99 nonprofits forwent the average \$1,395 fee to access Foundation Director Online (a nationally recognized online grant search database), freeing up funds to invest in other areas of their organization.
